## General Rules & Information

1. Judges and show official's decisions are final.
2. Food and beverages available on site.
3. All participants regardless of age must wear a helmet while mounted.
4. An OE membership is not required but is **strongly** encouraged. To sign up please visit their website <https://ontarioequestrian.ca/>
5. Show attire is not required but recommended. Clean breeches, half chaps or tall boots, gloves, helmet and hair tied back. For the March Kidney Care Show please wear purple to show your support!
- 6. We accept cash or cheque ONLY cheques are payable to Daisy Meadows Equestrian.**
7. Show numbers are not issued until entry fees are paid in full, no exceptions.
8. Classes will not start earlier than their posted time.
9. All entries not done using our online entry form will incur a \$25 admin fee. No exceptions. No refund.
10. Online entries will close the Wednesday before the show at 9pm.

12. Rings open at 8:00 am.
13. There is no fee charge for scratches, cancellations or changes made to classes / divisions.
14. Refunds are available for class scratches; you must alert ingate of a scratch so they have record.
15. Any participant who does not want to keep a ribbon a \$1 refund will be given. Ribbons must be brought back to show office in new condition on the same day as awarded during show office hours.
16. Any refunds will be given during show office hours only, on the show day.
17. Show office hours are 7:30 am to 3 pm.

## Day Stalls / Overnight Stalls

Day stalls are available in limited quantities for Show Day and the day before show day only. Stalls rentals are \$25 total per day. This is to be paid in cash only to the show office when you register for your classes on day of show. Stall rentals include one bedded stall. All hay, water buckets and extra shavings are to be provided by the renter. Please use our Online Entry form to reserve a day stall.

## Prize List & Year End Awards

1. Each class has ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
2. Each division will have a champion and reserve ribbon.
3. Year end ribbons will be awarded to 10th place.
4. To qualify for end of year points riders must attend 3 out of 5 shows
5. Year end awards will be rewarded based on points collected as follows: point value of placing X (times) the number of entries. (1st= 7, 2nd = 5, 3rd =4, 4th= 3, 5th= 2, 6th =1). [For example if rider places 2nd in a class of 11 entries: 5 X 11 = 55.] For jumper and hunter classes in the event of a tie the champion or reserve will be awarded to the rider/ horse with the most points over fences. For the flat classes in the event of a tie two Champions will be award with no reserve.
6. All questions should be directed to the show management and their decisions will be final.

## Show Fees

1. Hunter & Jumper \$20 tax included per class
2. Flat, Cross Rail & Novelty Classes \$15 tax included per class

3. All MJM Riding School students must pay a \$25 total horse rental fee and a \$30.00 total coaching fee.
4. **ALL FEES INCLUDING THE MJM RIDING SCHOOL FEES ARE TO BE PAID TO THE SHOW OFFICE ON SHOW DAY.**
5. Show numbers are not issued until all fees are paid in full. No exceptions.
6. We only accept cash and cheque (cheques paid to Daisy Meadows Equestrian).

# Novelty Class Descriptions

## Sunday October 28<sup>th</sup> 2018 – Halloween Theme

Both Ring One and Ring Two will have their own separate costume class. Judge to decide the winner based on creativity.

## Sunday November 25<sup>th</sup> 2018 – Christmas Theme

### Ring One: Relay Race

Teams of four mounted riders, one at a time each rider will hold a baton and race through a set course of 2' jumps. After completing the course will hand off their baton to the next rider in their team. Team that has all four members complete the race the fastest wins. Five seconds will be added for each rail knocked down while on course.

### Ring Two: Relay Race

Teams of four mounted riders, one at a time each rider will hold a baton and race through a set obstacle course consisting of poles and pylons. After completing the course will hand off their baton to the next rider in their team. Team that has all four members complete the race the fastest wins. Five seconds will be added for each obstacle knocked down while on course.

## Sunday January 20<sup>th</sup> 2019 – New Year's Theme

### Ring One: Relay, two riders one horse

This relay has teams of two riders with one horse to share. Each rider will start on opposite ends of the ring. The first rider will start mounted and have to go straight across the ring jumping single cross rail. When they reach their partner they must dismount & the second rider must mount without a mounting block! Your team mate can assist with a leg up. The new rider must then go across the ring heading towards home jumping the same cross rail. (Any previous knocked rails will be fixed) Each knocked rail adds 5 seconds. The team to complete the relay fastest wins.

#### **Ring Two: Musical Stalls**

Similar to musical chairs, mounted riders will ride around the outside of the ring while music plays. When the music stops they must maneuver their horse into a "stall" (stalls will be signified by poles on the ground in the middle of the arena. Any horses not in a stall will be eliminated. Each round a stall will be removed until there is only one left. The game will continue until only one rider remains and will be announced as the winner.

### **Sunday February 17<sup>th</sup> 2019 – Valentines Theme**

#### **Ring One: Hunter Pairs**

Find a Valentine date, this class requires a team of two! Compete over a set hunter course up to 2' as a pair in a row one behind the other. But riders will attempt to jump the final jump synchronized together, each rider will have their own jump. The team that completes it in unison with the fastest time with no rails knocked wins.

#### **Ring Two: Heart Shaped Relay**

This relay will have teams of two mounted riders. Two teams will compete simultaneously; one rider from each team will weave through poles down the ring to a basket full of paper hearts with instructions on the back. The rider will have to perform the task on the heart on the way back to their team mate. The team to successfully complete their tasks with the fastest time wins.

### **Sunday March 24<sup>th</sup> 2019 – Kidney Care Charity Show**

Both Ring One and Ring Two will compete simultaneously in Ring One for our Puppies and Ponies Obstacle Event! Lead your horse, pony or dog in a fun in hand obstacle course! There will be different classes based on animal. Fastest time wins!
